Location of the Event

President's Weekend will be held at the Park Hyatt Beaver Creek Resort and Spa, located at 136 East Thomas Place, Beaver Creek, CO 81620. The hotel's phone number is (970) 949-1234.

Check-In and Check-Out

Guaranteed check-in time is 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 4. If you arrive early, the hotel will do their best to accommodate you and will be happy to store your luggage until your room is ready. Check-out on Sunday, September 7 is at **12:00 p.m.**

Event Schedule

Our first organized event is the **Welcome Reception** on **Thursday, September 4, 2025, at 4:30 p.m.** The weekend will conclude on Sunday morning, September 7, 2025, with a final session that ends at approximately 10:30 a.m., allowing ample time for travel home.

Gratuities

Bellman (arrival and departure) and daily housekeeping gratuities have been prepaid on your behalf, along with your room charge.

Transportation and Travel

If you are flying, the closest airport is Eagle County Regional Airport (EGE), which is approximately a 30-minute drive from the resort. Denver International Airport (DEN) is about a 2.5-hour drive, depending on traffic and weather. Please note that there is ongoing road construction along I-70, so we recommend allowing extra travel time.

Transportation options from both airports to Beaver Creek include Epic Mountain Express (www.epicmountainexpress.com) and Peak 1 Express (www.mountainshuttle.com). Valet parking is available at the resort for \$15 per day.

Beaver Creek sits at an elevation of nearly 8,100 feet. To help prevent altitude sickness, we recommend staying well hydrated before and during your stay.

What to Pack

Early September in the Colorado mountains brings warm days and cool evenings. Typical daytime highs are in the low 70s, with temperatures dipping into the 40s at night. We recommend packing:

- Resort casual attire
 - Men: polos, button-downs, slacks, optional sport coats
 - o Women: blouses, casual dresses, skirts, or pants
- A light jacket or sweater (the ballroom can be cool)
- Comfortable walking shoes or hiking gear
- Sunglasses and sunscreen
- Swimwear, jeans, shorts, and layers for variable temperatures
